## ART IN TRUST

To celebrate the opening of our fantastic new facility we have put together an exhibition featuring some of the highlights of our wonderful fine art collection. The exhibition illustrates the breadth of the collection, spanning over 200 years of painting.

There is something for everyone to enjoy – landscapes, portraits, seascapes and still lifes. On display are works by many well-known artists, including William McTaggart, James McIntosh Patrick, Walter Sickert and L S Lowry. There are paintings by all four Scottish Colourists – Peploe, Hunter, Fergusson and Cadell – and Glasgow Boy, E A Hornel.
